


# London Society of the NLS Annual Programme, 2021-2022

# NLS / WAP Reading Seminar, Sundays from 10th October 2021 to March 2022



The biannual congress of the World Association of Psychoanalysis will take place in March next year, online. *The Great International Online Conversation* has started its preparations around its theme "Woman does not exist." As part of our preparations for the WAP conversation, we'll be reading a fundamental reference for the theme, **Lacan's Seminar XX**, *Encore*. A guest speaker, a psychoanalyst from one of the Schools of the WAP, will be presenting and commenting on a chapter of the seminar, followed by a small conversation with a discussant.

This aspect of our programme is online, free, and open to all. Attendees are encouraged to actively participate in the reading of this seminar by working in cartels.

# **Clinical Conversation**

Clinical presentations are a very important activity of clinical research and part and parcel of the psychoanalytic formation insofar as case construction is at stake. Constructing a case entails a form of writing that aims to catch what is most singular the subject. The clinical conversation consists of a case-based discussion, with a case presented by a clinician and commented in detail by an invited speaker in a closed group format. The discussion allows for an elucidation of the case with reference to theory and practice Five meetings have been organised this year and are open to members of the society only. # Reading Seminar: "Being and the One", November-June 2022

This is a reading of Jacques-Alain Miller's last seminar, delivered in 2011 under the auspices of the University of Paris 8. In this course, J.-A. Miller puts to work the opposition that appears throughout Lacan's last teaching, between ontology and henology, between "I am" and "there is", which Lacan writes in the form of a neologism : "Yad'lun" ("There's such a thing as One"). Each participant is encouraged to prepare a written commentary on relevant reading. The contributions are discussed in a closed group format.

Participants are expected to be able to attend the seminar in a London venue. Participation is limited. Advance registration is essential. The reading of the seminar is based on the work done by a translation cartel.
